Lorden Award for Outstanding Leadership in Service to Associated Students is established in order to honor a UCSB undergraduate student each academic year who has performed outstanding service to the Associated Students through her or his leadership for the organization. This leadership service is exemplified by a dedicated and consistent involvement in the Associated Students, and is marked by integrity, honesty, and a commitment to the ideals of the Associated Students. These ideals include protecting student rights, creating an open and positive campus atmosphere, increasing student participation in programs and projects, and uniting students to make a difference on the campus.

Nomination forms are due in the Associated Students Administration office by 5:00pm on May 1, 2013. Alternatively the form may be emailed to [deniser@as.ucsb.edu](mailto:deniser@as.ucsb.edu) by the same deadline. The recipient will be honored at the annual year-end Associated Students Banquet. Criteria:

- At least 6 quarters of involvement, including Associated Students boards and committees, Academic Senate committees, administrative and advisory committees, and other campus and community boards and committees.
- At least three areas of involvement with Associate Students. This may be represented by: committee work in different areas; committee work and Legislative Council or Executive office work; or Legislative Council and Executive Officer work
- A contribution to the improvement of the organization
- A contribution towards improved student-to-student relationships in the organization
- A contribution towards improved student-to-staff relationships in the organization
- A contribution to the enhancement of the undergraduate experience at UCSB through identifying a need, and committing time, energy and talent to that need
