Remove UCSA Foundation

Therefore let it be enacted by the Associated Students in the Legislative Council assembled:

SECTION 32. A.S. UCSA FOUNDATION A) Charge of the UCSA Foundation: The A.S. UCSA Foundation shall administer the UCSA lock in, ensuring that all monies collected go towards UCSA related expenses. This shall include but is not limited to the following: 1) Travel for both the statewide affairs office and interested students to any UCSA related meeting, conference, workshop, or other activity. 2) Membership fees. 3) Campus based UCSA campaigns. 4) Training for the statewide affairs office on UCSA related activities. 5) Research on statewide issues, including but not limited to legislation, state budget issues, and educational policies. 6) Coordination between UC campuses to provide information, support, ideas, and resources. - Campus advertising for UCSA itself, and how students can get more involved in UCSA and related activities.
