Restructure Student Commission On Racial Equality

Whereas: Legislative Council is short one BCC seat and;

Whereas: Former SCORE Chairs Celina Nicole Ayala and Paul Elliot Monge, and current SCORE Chairs Yvette Mendez and Nick Musni, have each stated that SCORE would benefit from the addition of a second Legislative Council representative;

Whereas: SCORE members feel Historian is not inclusive to all genders

Therefore let it be enacted by the Associated Students in the Legislative Council assembled: ARTICLE XI, SECTION 27 of the Legal Code of the Associated Students be amended to say: "B) Voting Membership:

- 1) Two (2) Commissioners
- 2) One (1) student representative from each EOP component
- 3) One (1) Two (2) Legislative Council Members
- 4) One (1) Residence Halls Liaison
- 5) One (1) Correspondence Coordinator
- 6) One (1) Treasurer
- 7) One (1) Historian Ourstorian
