A Resolution

To

Resolution to Remove Associated Students Salary Savings from the Overall Salary Projection Plan

Whereas: A Resolution to Protect Student Lock- Ins was passed on November 4, 2009, and;

Whereas: Associated Students should not have been asked to put forth the 63,368.07 in salary savings to the University, because of its breach of contract and illegality, and;

Whereas: Police and Animal Care were exempt from the furlough and their control point was not mandated to make up the salary savings to respective control point, and;

Whereas: Student affairs is the control point for Associated Students and is being asked to make up the \$63,368.07 from the division of Student Affairs, and;

Whereas: Student Affairs being asked to make up \$63,368.07 will still be an indirect tax on students through the division of Student Affairs, and;

Therefore let it be resolved by the Associated Students in the Legislative Council assembled: That Student Affairs will not have to account for Associated Student salary savings and the money that they pay back to the University
Let it be resolved: that Associated Students should be exempt from the Universities' salary-savings Projection such as police and animal care
