- 1. FTF: Game Night- 5/22
 - a. Ryanne- 63 people at 7pm, 78 at 10pm.
- 2. NoMBe in the Hub 5/24
 - a. Burrow- Digital board helped. Ticket sales were low due to high price and outside festivals. Day of, show went well. CSO's did not show up due to miscommunication. Some showed up and ASPB people filled in.
