1. Ridearound with Vice Chancellor Garry Mcpherson

 - Sev told Dennis about the sand or dirt in the lots by Carrillo and Engineering 2, many people slip on their bikes because their tires have no treads.
 - Possible campus safety issue.
2. CSO Bike sale on October 19th
 - 9am - 3pm in Parking Lot 32 by police station.
 - Jamie has helped us send out advertisements for the bike sale
3. Planning for bike light giveaway sometime this quarter
 - "Light Up The Night." A table was set up in front of the Pardall center to give out free bike lights.
 - Reserving November 13 as date for giveaway, 4:30-7:30 PM.
 - Some lights have been acquired but more need to be ordered. Currently there are 80 lights but 500 lights are expected to be given away.
 - Lights are ordered through the AS Bike Shop at wholesale prices.
 - Sev will talk to Adam tomorrow 10/17/19 about ordering 400-500 bike lights which cost about \$5 each.
 - The CHP officer needs more notice about the giveaway.
 - DJ needs to be brought in with equipment, last year the DJ came without anything.
 - CSOs know about the bike light giveaway.
4. Discuss Pardall Center bike tools repair
 - Sheriff's Department noted the bike tools need to be checked and replaced regularly.

- The 408 building will be removed but the bike paths will not be removed.
- Construction for many of these projects will start this academic year.
