- 1. 2019 Retreat
 - a. Feedback
 - i. More clarification on job duties and should discuss more before the year begins.
 - ii. More team and personal bonding.
 - iii. Nathaly- Getting food catered on Saturday may be more efficient.
 - iv. Gabe- Enjoyed department goals.
 - 1. Send any other thoughts to Kiyomi's form.
- 2. Lagoon Film - 9/25
 - a. Esteban- 568 people total. Screen company got there around 4:30, call time 6:30. Single serve snacks were good but violate AS sustainability code.
 - b. Should organize lines better.
 - c. Needed more space and time to pub Forky event. But people enjoyed it.
 - d. Tuesday films were up on the screen.
 - e. Guy from company took over mic but got people hyped.
 - f. Film was a little long.
 - g. Cleanup was fast and easy- out of the office around 10.
 - h. Kat- Flyered for Welcome Back at the movie- most places in IV let us put them up.
 - i. Kiyomi- People may not have known ASPB did the event. Try to announce more that it's US.
 - j. Should talk about people bringing lawn chairs? At the top it was hard to see.
- 3. Welcome Back - 9/28
 - a. Nathaly's post show notes:

 - b. Kari- Were supposed to get 9 scanners, but only got 5. Around 8, 5 more were brought over.
 - i. Entrance C was congested because of fewer scanners.

- ii. Not a lot of people on guest pass list came, only ~3.
 - iii. Parking passes- all but 5 were used.
 - iv. Will go in tomorrow and ask for a count because scanners erased the counts.
- c. Adam- Teams were cooperative and easy to work with.
 - i. Day before show- staging company showed up later than expected.
 - ii. Day of show- no problems with set up.
 - iii. Load up was slow, but some workers left.
 - iv. Overall, crew was good and Freestyle did a great job.
- d. Event safety
 - i. Fencing was an hour late- important to know who knows the map and where the fences should go.
 - ii. Carlos and Alexis- fencing got pushed back- people had to help unload barricades. Crew should have come earlier.
 - iii. Should have ordered more barricades.
 - iv. Understaffed because of how early event occurs in the year.
 - v. YBN's van near entrance C was understaffed.
 - vi. Contemporary(professional security) was great and showed up early.
 - 1. Very professional and asked a lot of good questions.
 - vii. Jordan, head of Contemporary, said they weren't sure what procedures to follow when artist asked for people on stage.
- e. Volunteers
 - i. Helped scan at the door.
 - ii. Volunteers helped reduce some stress.
- f. Hospitality
 - i. Set up on time for artist arrival.
 - ii. Used extra money unused from budget to get pizzas.
 - iii. Gabe- Riders weren't crazy, so it wasn't too bad.
 - 1. Only had to really clean YBN's room.
 - iv. Conner- Route set up to get talent to stage had direct access to student paths. Had to monitor because crew was going in and out a lot.
 - v. YBN decided to stay in his car until 20 minutes until his set- had to close off areas to get him to stage.
- g. Comments
 - i. Enaiya- One of the alumni said they never got a wristband.
 - 1. Kari- alumni came through entrance B, and were written down.
 - 2. MD- They usually aren't given wristbands and allowed backstage.
 - 3. Nathaly- can discuss on a show by show basis.
 - ii. Bethel- Ticket office said we should let them know 2 weeks in advance when we have events.
 - 1. Kari- Ray knew but didn't communicate it, so they didn't know- miscommunication.
 - iii. Gabe- Got called over to open the UCen a lot, should give other people access beforehand. Asked for tables, chairs, and things inside.
 - 1. Nathaly- Production and event safety should have access, along with special events coordinator.
 - iv. MD- If you are going to purchase food, it needs to be in the budget. In the future it needs to be talked about to see if it qualifies for purchasing dinner for people.
 - v. MD- Police usually don't have cars inside fences but they had 2 cars this time. Moved to side by bookstore instead of front of UCen. Asked them to let us know beforehand. Need better communication with CSO's and police.
 - 1. May be good to have police chief meet with us beforehand.

H. OLD BUSINESS

1. Roy Blair Hub Show - 10/11- Brett
 - a. Confirmed- Show in 12 days.
 - i. Hospitality rooms are reserved and graphic was sent last week, but they have been slow in responding.
 - ii. Want to get announcement ready for social media for tomorrow.
 - iii. Tickets will be ready by Wed at 10am. Sold at ticket office. \$12 for students, use perm number to buy. \$22 general, \$24 at door.
 - iv. Will be a meet n greet after show. Need to establish rules and figure out location.
 - v. Nathaly- Can use Welcome Back page to tell people.
 - vi. Lucas- Rider involves bringing own equipment- may need opener to use their equipment. Good with staffing.
 - vii. Working on pre-event meeting. Hard to schedule. Need to talk to everyone to figure out times to meet.
 - viii. Kiyomi- If we get poster edits, can we still announce before Wed when tickets go on sale.
 1. We could use an individual graphic with his approval.
 - ix. Nathaly- We can't announce the show until Brett gets the okay from the artist.
 - x. Creating a team for this event- but that's not how it works- people volunteer.
 1. Hub shows are half board events. Have to work at least 1 hub show to fulfill requirements.
 - a. Kiyomi- If you need to miss let me know.
 - xi. Gabe- Quick turnaround for ticket prices.
 1. Difficult to make money at any student show. Selling tickets at similar price for venues of ~1000 people.
 2. Kiyomi- Pub can do discounted tickets, giveaways.
 3. MD- See how ticket sales go first
 4. Nathaly- Ticket discount may only make a difference if it goes from double digits to single digits, but \$12 is fine
 - b. Opener discussion
 - i. Sent out suggestions on Friday and 2 different discussions- Artist A and Artist B
 - ii. Nathaly - need to get openers approved by artists management first.
 - iii. Kiyomi- Both seem comparable at this point.
 - c. BP
 - i. Just released an EP, interesting pop sound- tropicana pop- would match RB's sound.
 - ii. Kat- Artist B- compared to Blood Orange- on tour with Tyler- Childish Gambino tweeted one of their videos. Also compared to Drake's album. But last articles were from 2016.
 - iii. Nathaly- Artist B - All similar artists on Spotify we have had here and they have been successful. Would also be easier to have individual artist.
 - iv. Nathaly- could ask about doing a stripped down show because people know them outside their band.
 - d. P

- i. Band- over 30mil streams on Youtube.
- ii. Having a band would lean more toward an indie show.
- iii. Esteban- Production wise, is there a difference between single artist and band?
 - 1. Adam- Yes- Could have differences in equipment, but need to figure out. Need to see if there is enough money in the budget for backline for opener.

I. NEW BUSINESS

1. Artist C - 11/24- Gabe
 - a. Info page about them in Slack- Artist C - viners and youtubers.
 - b. On tour right now- ends 11/18, but talking to their agent. Played at many college campuses.
 - c. Artist C made a vine with racial slurs and has since apologized since, but it is an important point to bring up.
 - d. In the budget, their asking price was \$50k but I had \$20-40k. Do we want to lower end? (~\$15-30k)
 - e. Nathaly- IV theater vs Campbell?
 - i. More interactive things in IV, people may not want to travel on campus
 - ii. Kiyomi- Campbell = \$18k loss, IV Theater = \$30k loss if sold out. But pricing of different tickets affects gross potential.
 - iii. Nathaly- Changed pricing for offer (\$30k) and ticket prices (\$20 and \$30) and it was only a \$12k loss at Campbell
 - f. Brett- Going lower on offer price- risking not getting them. Should also see places they sold out and what their ticket prices were.
 - i. We book for a person, not a day or place.
 - g. Enaiya- Although controversial, they have a really big fanbase. Tend to go viral often. Loyal fan-base would be willing to go to Campbell.
 - h. UCR had a kickin it event with Artist C and can ask them about it.
 - i. Kat- Texas venue had 750 seats and did sell out.
 - j. Kiyomi- Madison theater- 1200 seats and people are reselling tickets for \$25. Budget may not be super feasible- significant loss at current prices
 - k. Nathaly- Other artists we are considering have also said controversial things and apologized and we still consider them, so if we aren't willing to book an artist, we shouldn't book a comedian.
 - l. MD- We don't have a budget we can vote on tonight. Also on the Sunday before Thanksgiving.
 - m. Kiyomi- Look at budgets beforehand.
 - n. Bethel- Similar talent: Artist D
2. Halloween or Christmas events?
 - a. Kiyomi- Anyone can throw an event
 - b. Bethel- Karaoke at rockfire- Christmas? Need facility agreement anyway so could start working on it.
 - c. Conner- Ice in Paradise Christmas event
 - d. Brett- Pumpkin carving day- knives= safe?
 - i. Or ugly pumpkin giveaway
 - e. Nathaly- Company that does haunted houses- could pub Delirium with a haunted house
 - i. Also, rockfire may not allow karaoke because of the success of their own karaoke nights

 - i. Prize could be free delirium ticket?
 - g. Greer- Christmas Luminaria event
 - h. Nathaly- Pets costume contest at park in IV
