1. 90 and 361 Agreement

Lau: Bill to regarding to allocate 90 and 361 agreement. What to call A.S unallocated and OSL allocated. BCC have to come and request per program and per event bases. OSL can request from this fund when the OSL fund is done. Point of the bill is to put it in writing. No less than \$60,000 no more than \$90,000 can be granted to Associated Students. OSL groups can request from the \$90,000 when the OSL fund is exhausted.

Cindy: you may have no reason to have a fund for the BCC's for the rest of the years. Budgets change throughout the years.

Martinez : counting on them for the BCC's and the University Units to be able to pull from somewhere.

Lele: When having a minimum for the BCC's to tap into. The OSL's should be able to tap into this money.

Jose: To be considered an internal lock-in it has to meet one of the eligibility requirements or be a BCC that advances accessibility and diversity. It's written in such a way to meet the promises the Students' Initiative made during the campaign and language of the initiative.

Martinez: Strike the \$90,000 maximum

Steven: Eligibility of the bill for the section of the financial legal code and treat it differently and a better place for this bill in the financial policies.

2. Conference Bill:

Clause 17 for conferences: All organizations that are funded for conferences from finance board should come back and hold a forum and tabling within the three weeks of the conference happening spreading what they learned at the conferences.
