 - e. For next year:
 - i. Make sure the stage is the right size. There needs to be more money in the budget for that. It was still a good enough size for FlyLo
 - ii. Dress professionally at our events. No cut offs, no tanks, wear closed toes shoes.
 - iii. Add more money to production.
 - iv. The legs on the Geni have to be further away from the barricades from the inside, because it could be a safety hazard.
 - v. Unsure about when a student opener should

vacate back stage. Keep contact with the artist at a minimal.

- vi. People were saying they were from the nexus when they aren't. People somehow got a pass to get backstage. Have better contact with KCSB in the future to avoid trouble in the future.
- vii. There were professional cameras in the crowd that we had to chase down.
- viii. If barricades come at 2pm sound should be at 10 am
- ix. We shouldn't be zip-tying the pipe and drape because it makes holes
- Friday stage would be very beneficial and convenient. Takes away from day of show.
- xi. People got on the top balcony
- f. Make a rule with media that we would give them one warning and then kick them out if they keep coming back and breaking our rules.
- g. We need to make clear that media outlets need to tell us before the day of. We should no allow media to come day of if they haven't contacted us.
- Security wouldn't look at the badges to check the time that they are allowed back stage
- i. We had DJ times for when they are allowed to be back stage to be on air
- j. CSO's were suppose to be covering upstairs, but they weren't walking around covering the whole area.
- k. We aren't suppose to be dancing back stage even though the artist may be okay with it, it makes us look very unprofessional.
- I. We have had many problems with KCSB following our rules with backstage. We really need to communicate our rules to them.
- Barricades need to be wider next year. One person was arrested.
 Many citations. Miller was punched in the face.
- n. Make sure the artist is on the same page regarding interviews
- A cop escorted a girl back stage to go and talk to Zoe, which was not okay. If someone wants access or needs to talk to the coordinator take

them to the person, not the other way around.

- p. There is not really any reason to have anyone back stage besides security and ASPB members.
- q. The opener wanted friends to help him move his stuff, and it was unclear whether or not we should allow them backstage
- r. Possibly contact the news station first to make sure they know who they have to talk to.
- s. If your not hospitality, a runner, or running they show you should not be back stage.
- t. We should have a post event to discuss what went wrong.
- u. The sound crew opened up the barricades while the artist was still back stage with out asking or letting anyone know.
- v. We usually don't give them passes with just have a list and keep them at their station
- Books were still left in the lobby by the book store that had to be monitored by someone
- x. Have the info desk in a well lit corner and the bathroom signs where they could be more visible.

 - f. Some reviews for artificial skating haven't been very positive.

 - i. The 15th would be the best date out of the options
- 3. Kevin Hart
 - a. Ticket prices are still relatively cheap at a close breaking even point.
 - **b.** We would start at 120K
 - c. We need to look into an advertising plan before we could send out the offer.
 - d. Rachel and Geo:

- i. Made list of all of the radios startions that we could reach
- ii. Locations: everything between SLO and SB
- iii. Promotion would be what we would do for extravaganza but on a bigger level
- iv. Have promotion to give away two tickets so that more people may be interested
- v. Promote to all of the comedy events here on campus
- vi. Look into a local add on comedy central
- vii. Look into the cost individually for publicity to see how much it would exactly be
- viii. We could see how many we hold until we open it up to sell to general.

- xiii. The 18th is only a month and a half away that could be too soon considering how long it takes to get an offer out and confirmed.
- xiv. With his following \$32 is not that much to pay for Kevin Hart, considering the venue
- xv. We still want to push out an Ecen show this quarter just not at this big of a scale
- xvi. Mikey: His name is hart we could do it around valentines
