- 1. EAB Earth Day 4/29 came back w/full list of bands and filled out park contract; on Sat 4/29 from 1-7pm with tabling, food from IV Co-Op, activities like yoga, succulents, bands, etc
 - a. Reached out to couple bands \rightarrow 6/7s said their equipment is low budget and won't be good enough for other bands
 - b. Josue: best to have drum kit to be the main thing to be shared
- 2. IV Arts 4/7 Emily from assistant for IV arts and 4/7 is very first First Friday for them; event from 6-11pm
 - a. need mics and extension cords but need people to set them up → need tech help from ASPB
 - b. diff bands there like 67s, BFOM, general Jazz band from music dept, thinking of doing mic night at 10pm
- 3. Vogue Club 4/14 Ernie rep for Vogue Club and queer clubs on Campus; last year spent \$4,000 due to no support
 - a. Request show for co-sponsored event w/ 6 event staff
 - b. Run time where doors open at 8 and end at 11:30; located at HUB
 - c. Looking for local talent and in contact w/talents

 - a. Need for sound for this Thursday from 6-8pm

F. WEEK IN REVIEW

- 1. Assassin's Creed 2/28
 - a. Kailah: 38 at first show and 87 at second show
- 2. Open Mic Night 3/1
 - a. Kailah: went really well w/19 people performed; used new system where people can sign up via email to solidify spots and helped gave priority but there was slight confusion; 9 people who signed up went there and 10 people who signed up before went there; 130 people there for peak attendance
 - i. Couple of comedians there that got kind of offensive so told them to wrap it up and started cutting down people's time; some people were upset
 - ii. Some people couldn't go on naturally due to a lot of people there
 - iii. EOS afterwards was annoying due to no notice of it occurring; people got rowdy
 → wasn't really professional to have two events in one night
 - b. Katie: people went up to her saying how much they enjoyed the event and want it more often; possibly having it longer or having two next quarter

- 3. Dope Metaphors 3/5
 - a. Josue: good and easy show; weren't informed that they wouldn't have a keyboard but still good show and went smoothly
- 4. Cooler Hats 3/6
 - Justin: peak attendance was 70 sitting there for extended event and band played for entire hour; really great performance; keeping storke shows on Monday and Wednesdays
 - b. Katie: setting up was really easy; hard to get stuff at beginning but just due to parking
 - c. Ernie: made volunteer sign up sheer where it should be emailed

G. PREVIEW OF THE WEEK

- 1. Sing 3/7
 - a. Kailah: people working at 7= Alex, Katie, Isabella, and Justin; working at 10= Shahar, Tarush, Ernie and Justin
- 2. Dead Week DIY
 - a. Faith: need 4 people from 6-9 to monitor; mugs should come later this week
- 3. Bagel Day
 - a. Jazz: on March 20 and 21st from 7:30-5pm; Jazz and Ernie would be there all day but would love if people can come by
 - b. Christina: if printing posters, pick them up at office; believes that longer to have online, won't need to have actual physical posters

H. OLD BUSINESS

- 1. Stipends
 - a. Marilyn: went over ASPB budgets from last year, this year and projected
 - i. Remainder at end of 2015-16 year was \$315; rollover was \$342
 - Year of 18-19 may end up having decline
 No longer receive \$\$ from Chancellor for ECen shows.
 - ii. Budget in office
 - 1. Next year will include staff salary.
 - b. Faith: observed rollover decreased due to going over budget; agreed w/Christina to show board next year on wariness of budget even though it's \$1mil
 - c. Tarush: need clarification for total budget for 16-17 was \$1.3 and total expenditures was $$1.1 \rightarrow $$ we are going over our lock-in; reason starting budget is higher is due to cap and summer
 - d. Sarah: asking about amt left aside from Extravaganza money and co-sponsorship
 - i. Bo: (rough estimate) will work on getting better number
 - e. Bo: passed \$5,500 for co-sponsorships so either more people working or working longer than expected
 - i. Good that we are spending money but we should be aware of over-spending and to look over budget more carefully
 - ii. Stipend conversation to be ongoing as we can't do anything for this year
 - f. Alex: asked about expecting how stipends will change → to be discussed later
- 2. Promo Items
 - a. Ernie: two items but hoping to send out budget before spring program starts

- i. Two items: carabineers where water bottle can clip on to them and reusable bag that can fold into strawberry shape
 - 1. Carabineers to be \$1,000
 - 2. Thinking bags to have AS Food Bank to table during Storke show and use them at Food Bank
- ii. Total budget for 3,200; \$1,830 for bags
 - 1. About 1,600 items: 1000 for carabineers and 600 for bags
 - 2. Argument on amount of bags to be somewhat a lot
 - 3. Believes expensive per unit due to how it's foldable → solution to have a tote for a cheaper alternative
- b. Tarush: like to have logo on carabineers
- c. Christina: believes if we are to spend on expensive promo item, we should use it more strategically like w/pre-screenings or any events in general; it should be viewed to be more special

3. High Tables -

- a. Taylor: not many places spending 4ft tall tables; cheapest and highest that I can find is 3 ft maybe 3 ½ ft table
 - i. Second is 8 ½ ft long
- b. Josue: best thing is professional riser table due to amt of times ordering tables; we are looking for 3x8 w/4ft riser
 - i. Currently looking and usually paying \$50/table for delirium
- c. Alex: agrees w/Josue on how these tables are an industry standard
- d. To be discussed again

4. The Warm Up -

- a. Alex: sent email w/all options
 - i. Has few more options and based on received emails, most popular options are A, B, C, D, E, F; lots of C
 - ii. We had issues with Snoop Dogg where there was a huge rush at the doors. Having two openers might help this
 - 1. In Fall w/ Flatbush and YG was a big difference because there was no rush with a solid name pull with the opener
 - iii. Believes lot of debate b/w H, J playing in SB recently
- b. Conflicts of Interest:
 - i. WME: Sophia, Shahar, Sarah, Tarush, Sam, Christina, Bo
 - ii. Paradigm: Sophia, Shahar, Justin, Alex
 - iii. CAA: Sophia, Justin, Alex, Tarush, Sam, Christina, Bo
 - iv. Circle Talent: none
- c. Justin: whole two opener thing is a good idea and hoping for A and C; we shouldn't play same openers as those for EOS
 - i. Hate K so much; G has new album; believes B to not have popular name
 - 1. Transition from C to headliner to be smooth
- d. Faith: if picking lower name, should only choose one and this can help save \$10K
- e. Bo: believes C plays here too often but likes B
- f. Sam: have reconsiderations on two openers due to budgets; believes having two openers for having \$15K or less to be good idea
 - i. Not focusing on J enough but recent show didn't sell out

- ii. Getting B for good price can be best bet since he's been doing more hip hop stuff
- iii. Believes two small openers isn't a good idea rather wanting a really good opener
- g. Christina: likes B as option since more well known; name pull is going to be much larger; understands genre difference and the energy to transition from diff music won't be bad
 - Believes K to be most versatile to audience and show itself; genre discrepancy to be smaller
- h. Tarush: likes A as option and just others vibe much better; but not B b/c sound is too different but does have in pull
 - i. Likes B in general but feel people are hyping him up right now but not really that popular; has less FB mutual likes compared to other options
- i. Taylor: agree w/Christina for B; whole deal is w/doors last year having a huge big name pull; name pull to bring people early and rush to door for main act → should have a big name pull
- j. Ernie: likes J and having show early last quarter gave her a wanting from her even though didn't sold out; advocate for her since we don't have much women representing our shows and should have her as opener
- k. Kailah: having two openers that are smaller would make people possibly want to come later
- I. Sophia: if two small openers, it would deter people more; not for G thing since played here twice; two strong options are B and F
- m. First Round two votes

- n. Contingency option two votes
 - i. J: 4

- o. B is first option; A as contingency option; C as 2nd contingency option
- 5. Food Truck
 - a. Bo: Meeting w/Marilyn and Alex about Deltopia with admin talking about food truck idea; Spring Insight is the same day as Deltopia → there are day time activities to keep families on campus so idea of food truck can help
 - i. A food truck has been proposed for Warm-Up; can offer other locations not near our event
 - ii. Sum of opposing food truck→ should be located elsewhere; if admin really wants it, then we would want to have certain conditions
 - b. Sam/Sarah/Katie/Shahar: doesn't like it b/c of potential trash; concerned w/line situation
 - c. Ernie: ok w/not having food truck

- d. Jordan: food trucks during day for Spring Insight= parents/children; and at night for students → don't like the idea
- e. Tarush: likes idea of having food truck located away from Thunderdome
- f. Josue: people don't carry money w/them in general when they go out
- g. Jazz/Taylor: people generally don't have cash anymore and possibility of loss of tickets/lds
- h. General consensus: No to the food truck. If they persist, then we push for a different location.

6. X17 -

- a. Justin: talked to Shawn who is ahead of IT for AS
 - i. Real time sharing for photo booths to be popular → not possible to be implemented; possibility of renting wifi (Mifi) from photo booth company (extra \$100); can have live slideshow
 - 1. Currently have \$1,650 for photo booth
 - ii. Everyone is for this
- b. Alex: price for co-sponsorships
 - i. Ernie: No to three due to not being in conjunction on what we are looking for: PETA, shoe company giving out tacos, and another
 - 1. No confirms as of now; KIND only one for now;
 - 2. Potentiality of not having Daily Nexus ads → thoughts of using social media ads instead
 - ii. Christina: Red Bull is be up for it but don't want to pay for spot; Five Hour Energy has been contacted as well
- c. Justin: believes lawn games would go super well with theme (i.e. Connect4, Jenga)
- d. Christina: quotes
 - i. Bandanas option not available right now but will email later
 - ii. Flag options and rentals
 - iii. Change w/festival map to be have slight charge
- e. Marilyn: has anyone looked into different options on porta-floor? None

7. Storke Show-

- a. Justin: has \$4K budget
 - i. Brought up insurance → talent wants \$150 for insurance to be covered
 - 1. Marilyn: band should have their own insurance
 - ii. Have \$7K for talent for Storke shows; holistically not going to spend \$3K in future
 - iii. Didn't spend \$1K on budget this quarter→ spent less than \$4K
- b. Sam/Shahar: should keep momentum for Storke Shows
- c. Argument on increase price for insurance
 - i. Marilyn: use Hub show as negotiation as same price range
- d. Justin: Average price for Storke show is generally fairly low
 - i. Having a bigger artist for Storke show would definitely have 10x attendance
