Bike System Improvement Projects

Kerr Hall

With the addition of 40 PeakRacks Kerr Hall parking now has 197 bike parking spots. However, to fully elevate overcrowded parking there must be 300+ parking spots. The vendor expects that if all the racks at Kerr Hall were replaced with peak racks the total cost would be \$18,720 (208 spaces x \$90/space = \$18,720) generating 51 NET NEW parking spaces for a cost per NET NEW of \$367 per space. At the AS BIKES meeting yesterday there was a willingness expressed to offer upto an additional \$15K to re-rack ALL of Kerr. Another option would be to replace a portion of the existing racks with PeakRacks. This would create 20 NET NEW spaces and the cost for this would be \$7200 (80 spaces x \$90/space = \$7200) \$360 per NET NEW space.

HSSB/SRB Improvements

Sarah Henkel, Jayme Wagner, Marc Fisher, and Dennis Whelan to do a walk around Thursday January 24th to discuss options for new parking at HSSB as well as adding more parking and a safe dismount area to the SRB parking. Also, Sarah and Marc will discuss funding for these new projects. If these projects are approved then we can possibly use Facilities Management funds for the SRB project. AS BIKES would probably use their funds for the HSSB project Parking Services has \$5K left over from the CalTrans BTA grant and \$2,200 left over from the \$10K donor gift leaving \$7,200 to put toward HSSB from existing non-AS funding. Perhaps a bit of funding for racks at HSSB from AS will be desired...Dennis is working on a sketch for the rack vendor Dennis has done a sketch of or Drama-Dance SRB including a left turn lane and re-orienting the racks perpendicular to the bikeway. If Marc agrees with the design we can approach Maryann for a price estimate and see if FM will pay the entire tab. In response to changing the stop sign at the intersection to a yield sign Larry said that while he personally feels it should be a yield sign the University has less liability with a stop sign.
