Business

- 1. Budget update: \$88k, \$6k left over from last year
- 2. FM and Chancellor's Money: Documents sent by Alan Williams seem to reflect the money we have spent, not matching funds
- 3. Policy recommendation

What can Legislative Council do for us at this stage?

Bike System Improvement Projects

- 1. Add to list:
 - a. IV Theater Parking
 - b. Harder Stadium (parking and path to get there)
 - c. Yield sign at Noble/Psych intersection with Library
 - d. Parking and Pedestrian Refuge at SRB
- New Construction:
 - a. Graduate Housing Roundabout Ron Strahl contractor want to bring to meeting
 - Engineering: planning to eliminate bike rack, will they put it back? Contact fisher
- 3. Walk Bike Signs:

Big improvement at West Gate: 80-90% walking, only giving 2-3 citations per day

1 h of officer presence combined with signs seems to be really effective Ticket costs \$124, but can attend Bike Safety Class for \$35 which eliminates ticket

Money earned from class goes to buy bikes for officers, etc.

- 5. Measure D is going to be on the Ballot Nov 2008
- 6. Working with the Public Safety Committee

 - b. PSC Action Item Log was ALL Bike issues
 - c. Next Public Safety Meeting will be Tuesday Nov 13 and will focus on bike parking: Sarah will present Bike Policy Document at that meeting
 - d. They added to our Bike System Projects List:
 - i. Bike parking at RecCen
 - ii. Entry to bike path at Goleta Beach
 - iii. Bike Lane at FT is difficult to distinguish from sidewalk: recommendation for FM to restencil lines there as a start
 - e. Updates:
 - i. Library weird intersection should be redesigned when Library Infrastructure project happens
 - ii. All problems near Music: They made working drawing to improve this area but have no funding. Total project would cost about \$300k. If you just did area directly in front of Music, might be able to get something good for \$150k
