- b. Dustin Gaucho FYI is already in place
 - a. An education program every first year is required to complete
- c. Emily Ralph has supported Caltrans form of markings on bike path
 - a. Dennis- not in support of Caltrans
 - i. Cannot stop the influx of traffic into round-a-bouts
- d. Tom Is there data where the bike crashes occur
 - a. Matt- We can only record the info that is brought to us
- e. Scott- supports putting up sandwich board yield signs, safety tips along path
 - a. Perhaps during a bike safety week
 - i. Mac can use special projects fund
 - ii. Upload videos onto Digiknow for students
 - b. Make other signs too including single file, on the right side, etc.
- f. Dennis- there are permanent signs that we should take the next steps into implementing
- g. Scott- a follow up committee should be formed to move things along, next steps
- h. Matt-something to keep in mind is that most accidents occur due to high speeds
- Dennis housing is putting 1000 more students at San Joaquin (near San Clemente)
 - a. Housing should be responsible for some improvement projects
