Business

- 1. Sarah reports on Public Safety meeting
 - a) They seem to agree with our conclusion of overcrowded bike parking
 - b) Suggested that we do a targeted survey of bike parking
 - c) Maybe swap out old racks with new peak racks at targeted location
- 2. Jayme suggests that putting in new racks to test efficiency is not a good idea
 - a) Too expensive for test, each peak rack is \$80 each total of \$16,000 for HSSB for example
 - b) There is \$12,000-\$14,000 left from cal grant specifically for bike parking that is possibly available for our use

Bike Policy

1. Draft of Policy was sent out to everyone at the Public Safety meeting, decided to send it to members who weren't there as well, to get feedback.

Outreach

- 1. Bike Gripe
 - a. Chris reordering 250 flashing bike lights, total of \$325 and about 8 days to get here- approve up to \$350 to purchase bike red flashers with AS logo for outreach. Approved unanimous.
 - Discussed survey, Sarah is going to update with BIKE members suggestions
 - c. Sarah motions and Chris seconds running ad for Bike Gripe up to \$500 in the Daily Nexus November 26th-28th. Approved unanimous
