## 4. Projects and Programs

- a. Bike Rack Assessment- review and send full data to CSO Working on getting pictures, done very soon.
- B, Encourage CSO to prioritize area to be cleared up; Unfortunately, primarily complaint driven, make complaints and see progress!
- 5. Priority Project List
  - a. SAASB intersection, up to \$15,000 unanimously approved for completion of project over winter break, also approved 10% of project cost to pay maintenance. Nathan will get back to committee on cost for repaving up to bus stop, maybe able use facilities funding. Goal: shrink planter, create to 2ft of space on each side, unfortunately this may confuse students as there is no turn lane. Project will include resurface Bike Path to Base of Tunnel (Stop @ Tunnel Entrance). \$15K was approved in May 2008. This project will GREATLY improve the safety of this currently dangerous intersection.

MOTION: approve up to \$15,000 construction of new intersection, demolition and repaying, striping and resurfacing of path at intersection to base of tunnel. Unanimous

  Nathan will fill out a project initiation form for bid out

- 6. Repaving in front of AS Bike Shop

Nathan will fill out PIF form to get estimate. Work to be completed over winter break. Maintenance funds from Facilities will help offset total cost of project so it will be much less than approved. Approve is just to be sure. The committee is excited to complete this project since it is the most highly degraded section on campus. The project will include the resurfacing and striping from the circle near the bus loop and extend across the new ESSB all the way to HSSB.

MOTION: approve up to \$20,000 for repaying, striping for bike path adjacent to AS Bike shop. Unanimous.
