- New bid for 456 racks (up from 230), total cost is \$31,650
- "Peak" will also take care of lot layout
- Update on budget—exceeded the initial \$40,000 budget
  - According to MaryAnn, an additional \$5K should cover it.
  - Nathan will ask the Rec Cen for an additional \$2,000, try to split costs, then AS BIKES only \$3,000 but should approve up to \$5,000 just to keep project moving forward
    - Motion to approve an additional up to \$5,000 for the Rec Cen Improvement Project
