Business

- 1. Budget update- uncommitted balance= \$39,720.00
- 2. Campus Bike Rack & Path assessment Need to identify the bike racks to be put in ASAP (like Psych Bldg.) Define the best bike rack type (3) for each particular place, to be installed on each particular surface. Chris to take post-election survey on what type and where students prefer improvements, put on web too. (mention to formally continue to pay Chris \$500 for Spring Quarter work!) Yet there is the need to consider budget, space, dimensions, etc. Brian to write up a formal document to define racks with specific features, cost, types, etc. Should we phase out old racks? Bikes should not pay for this. The new bike standard will be referred to in all cases of new building/ maintenance.
- 3. Abandoned Bikes Enforcement
- 4. Campus policy Need to switch path and parking bullets. Mention need for parking by/in view of front entrance of buildings, bike lot has access from bike path. Change "we"s and "should"s.

Bike System Improvement Projects

- 1. Campus bike path tour thurs april 26 2:00 Bus loop
- 2. Lighting to Goleta Beach
- 3. Timing for new Rack at Psych, Lifesci illegal parking- Need to talk to Dennis. This should be included in new bike policy.
- Bike lockers placement and timeline- The company has been paid, but they still need to be fabricated. TAP manages the lockers, Need to get update from Jaime
- 5. Pardall corridor- Need to decide to re-slurry all of the pardall path, but project must be less than \$15,000. Would a re-slurry on a recent coat even help? Need to walk path with Maryanne and Al.
- 6. Bus loop parking and adjacent pathways March 12th the driveway was re-paved but none of the bike path. The bus area parking is now

completely on us. The bike racks look very cleaned-up though, most old bikes removed. Should we pave the dirt triangle? Is there is a desire to put in all new racks? The project must be under \$25,000. Need to re-slurry only in patches. Need to walk it again with Maryanne. The north perimeter was marked by the bike race held last Sunday. All "danger" spots marked with spray paint. Is there a way to utilize this demarcation?

- 7. West Campus Bluffs Path- Shoreline has voted to approve \$20,000.
- 8. SRB inadequate parking- Underestimated need for parking?
- 9. Next improvement project- Chart re-evaluated shows that next most important project is either San Rafael/Lot 23 path from Ocean Road East to Service Road, Ocean Road at El Nido, Bike racks at Life Science, or Bus Loop. Need to wait on El Colegio/Los Carneros Feeder project and El Colegio West of Santa Ynez path. Need to check state of bike path north of events center and redo the chart key.
