Gold level Bike Awards

- SB awarded Gold level, beat by Stanford, who emphasizes education
- Jamey—we won't be considered for another award for another 4 years.
- Emily is in contact with RHA about setting up an Education program for bike safety regulations.
- Some interest in Leg Council, can collaborate to receive more funding.
- Duncan—create an educational workshop for freshman orientation on how to properly ride a roundabout, how to lock your bike, etc. Could get money approved from Leg council for new program
- David—important to keep distributing bike maps
- Nathan—include bike map in freshman orientation project

Nathan—Spring Break Projects

- Library circle installed
- Rec Cen—racks taken out of Rec Cen were moved to HSSB on the East side, reduced illegal parking at HSSB (David says reduced illegal parking at about 80%)
- Sabado pothole was fixed
- Picasso uplift was paved over
- Library parking has been re-instated. Removed a significant amount of foliage and laid racks back in.
 - We should consider repaving lot, hasn't been re-done since the 1970's
 - Reservation—upcoming construction site will mean about 30% of lot. Project temporarily on hold until

Possible projects list

- Re-do path in front of ROTC, which is still blue from original installation, install new peak racks as well.
- Re-stripe the SAASB intersection

- Pardall Intersection
 - 150 feet of private property between county maintenance line and university property.

 - Anton—could we put in mirrors to increase visibility
