1. Introductions

2. General Announcements

- i. This will be the last time AS BIKES meets this year. We will be deciding which projects to tackle on over the summer.

3. AS BIKES Business

a. SRB

- i. Dennis brought to the meeting a schematic of the newly proposed SRB parking layout
 1. Replace current racks with maximized Peak Racks
 2. Altered east-west alignment of racks
 3. Paving over planters
 4. Stripe a turning lane
- ii. Dennis suggests that we split the project into 2 portions, North and South
 1. He will get back to us with the costs

MOTION:

MC Pfaff, approval for up to \$25,000 for racking portion north of walkway with Peak Racks and all of the repaving with the stipulation that the committee gets to see the budget to ensure it is a reasonable cost

- b. South Hall and Storke Circle repaving, resurfacing, and restriping
 - i. Projected to cost around \$25,000, same as Phase I. Might be less because circle is smaller but we will probably need to extend south and east of circle
 - ii. We will also be looking into bids that include repaving South Hall parking lot and comparing the differences in costs
 1. Parking lot includes east and west side of path on east side of South Hall
 2. Northeast corner of South Hall lot still not paved
 - iii. Repaving will include official sidestriping to differentiate between parking lot and bike path
 - iv. The committee will plan a walkthrough with the contractor

MC Pfaff, approval to fund up to \$25,000 to repave, resurface, and restripe South Hall bike path and Storke Circle

c. West Campus Bluffs

- i. A project that we have funded in the past that has been delayed because there was no restoration plan in place
 - 1. BIKES contributed \$20K and Coastal Fund \$ which went to soft costs. \$15K was returned to the account since then, which can still be available to the project
- ii. Coastal Conservancy contributed 175\$K worth of grant money. the bid for this project will go up next month to be completed over the summer
- iii. May need more funding to complete project est \$225K. Will consider \$10-20K to contribute to complete the project after bid is complete.

d. Maintenance

- i. Strategize maintenance projects priority lists by quadrants of campus to see bigger projects worked around in a logical fashion- need GIS mapping with project description and date completed
- ii. Committee should get together with Marc Fisher to schedule another ride around
- iii. Contact Housing about taking care of the drop off by San Raf path
- iv. Adding Campbell to maintenance list for summer
 - 1. Cutting hedges

e. Rec Cen Parking

- i. Dennis working on making a schematic
- ii. Rec Cen governance board financing more racks to expand parking

f. Ucen/Music corridor expansion

- i. Ucen doesn't have enough money right now to fund

g. Tagging bikes

- i. Need to tag abandoned bikes so that CSO can do major bike abatement during the summer and clean out all the racks
- ii. Michell will continue to tag bikes on weekends and send the data to CSO
- iii. Michell will inquire what Housing does with their abandoned bikes

4. Outreach

a. Spring Bike Auction/ Fall Auction Follow up

- i. 32 bikes auctioned off for over \$2000 grossed.

- 1. Auction could not run as smoothly due to CSO being understaffed, and set up was one hour late

- ii. Michell is still waiting to hear back from Rob Crew about the possibility of having 2 fall bike auctions, one during move-in weekend and one in the beginning of the quarter that can be advertised to the whole campus
- b. Brochures- need 5000 for campus orientation- give to all incoming students. Great publicity!
