- requesting total of \$2880.50 for medicine
 - -includes detailed breakdown
- -project is a week long trip to Honduras in June 2013
- -educational component: hold public health/preventative health care workshops
- -say they are in communication with the community leaders to make sure they have a lasting impact by researching common diseases of areas, followup

(funded by CAB Foundation in Spring 2012 for "Lose the Training Wheels" event) -asking: \$600 for books, \$200 for facility fee for trainings, \$100 for training refreshments, \$200 for notebooks, \$500 for book bags, \$1000 plane tickets for facilitator conference in Chicago, \$100 for

Chicago conference registration, \$219 for hotel for Chicago conference total: \$2,919 -promotes community

- -Kristy: We probably won't fund the conference
