Danielle and Marina interviewed

- -asking \$1,920 for stipends (2)
- -IV teen center alumni from SBCC are being upgraded to interns
- -We would fund stipends
- -concern of funding SBCC stipends and not directly to UCSB students
- -Start November, year long
- -UCSB students will be benefited indirectly because these interns help the UCSB student volunteers
- -Three paid UCSB students; two interns unpaid at the moment, this would give them a more formal "position"

- -These two students would each work 8-15 hours a week
- -Danielle: sustainable, creating positions for the future, giving students more responsibility, more legitimacy to putting "intern" on resumé
- -Kristy: Stipend more of a thank you to the interns for their work
- -Recommendation from Danielle: unsure of the viability of program, how it exactly fits our mission statement in regards to involvement with UCSB students
- -Recommendation from Marina: unsure
