B. ACTION ITEMS

a. Global Medical Brigades- Interview

-Julie and Coco: recommend full funding -Student run- UCSB chapter (OSL) -Requesting total of \$2998.50 for medicine -Includes detailed breakdown

-Coco: medicine used to draw people in (first people get healthy, then they learn more) -Going to a bigger community because GMB big enough (different clinic from last year) -Still new, trying to get partnerships with major companies -Kristy: they applied a few years ago, we didn't fund them -37 UCSB students going, plus some local physicians -GMB students make decisions

Motion to fully fund Global Medical Brigades \$2,998.50 for various medication:

Dicloxacillin 500mg- \$42 Ibuprofen- \$1104 Trimethoprim 400-80mg- \$700 Albuterol Inhaler- \$159 Folic acid 800 mcg- \$750 Korin- \$127.50 Clotrimazole- \$116

b. Next Chapter Book Club- Interview

-Danielle and David

-promotes literacy and community for teens and young adults with intellectual disabilities -asking: \$600 for books, \$200 for facility fee for trainings, \$100 for training refreshments, \$200 for notebooks, \$500 for book bags, \$1000 plane tickets for facilitator conference in Chicago, \$100 for Chicago conference registration, \$219 for hotel for Chicago conference: total: \$2,919

-Promotes community among members and larger society

-Based in Santa Barbara

-Danielle: the books are specially made to be easy for disabled persons to read (larger font, spaced out)

-"Library" would be a collection of their books, not at a specific place

-Conference: not necessary or a priority

-22 UCSB volunteers, planning on growth (trainings)

-They need funding for expansion

-Danielle and David recommend full funding without the conference

-Notebooks: they could get their own notebooks, but if they were provided it would be more convenient

-Book Bags: Say Next Chapter Book Club on them; it would be easier for them to take along, it is like a tote bag; we would ideally have our logo on the bag, but as long as we are mentioned in a flier or something it is all right

Motion to allocate \$600 for books, \$200 for facility fee for trainings, \$100 for training refreshments, \$200 for notebooks, \$500 for book bags (Total \$1600) to Next Chapter Book Club, with the stipulation that acknowledgement of funding for books bags is mentioned on a website, flyer, etc. (Funds to be taken from AS Account #321 and to be spent no later than September 26th, 2013)

c. Wilderness Youth Project (WYP)- Interview

-Megan and Megan

-Budget not specific for this application, but includes administration, program fees, transportation

etc., all categories exceed our Major grant value

-in interview WYP requested money for staff salary/stipend (part of our mission statement?)

-gave pie chart with spending costs

-They have around 15 volunteers from UCSB; 9 full time staff, 16 part time staff, serve 600 kids per year

-sliding scale costs, reach various schools from low-income communities

-Funding: thinking they would ask kids from Montecito and wealthier communities; build their client base of donors for sustainability

-Want to build better relations with Latino community at UCSB so they can act as volunteers so as to connect with some of their students better

-they want \$3000 for the Volunteer Coordinator -Megan and Megan recommend partial funding; this is because it is just a stipend, it is only benefiting the kids indirectly, also the money goes to staff and not volunteers -board as a whole concerned with funding stipend -the Volunteer Coordinator already has a salary, knew what the position would entail -our potential funding would not directly benefit the children or the cause - their sustainability plan doesn't seem very reliable
