- Requesting: \$3,000 total (same requests as Spring 2012)

\$250 education workshop \$750 water storage tank \$2,000 pipeline construction materials

- trip is in August/September (before our Fall funding cycle)

- have been going to Kenya for 5 years
- seem to have a lot of effective funding sources

- Marina: distance seems pretty far
