

Environmental Affairs Board, Core Board Meeting
Monday, October 2nd 2006

Meeting Commenced at 8:14

First meeting starts a week from tomorrow. AS election coming up, fee increase for all of AS. Election is October 23 (presented). Voter has choice to double fees or not. Give 11 thousand more. EAB needs to decide whether or not they want to be on the ballot. If it passes and EAB doesn't sign on then there is no way to get on the ballot for four years. If EAB chooses to be on the ballot then we support the measure. We can potentially use the money for more causes and we don't have to use the money this year. As a group we would receive 25 cents more a quarter. Could hire someone to maintain the web site, good causes would be found to spend the money. AS is saying that if you want to be on this ballot AS wants to see where the groups would spend the money. A list would be made of where the money could go to: expanding Earth Day, newer projects, website, etc. Guaranteed is the fact that w/out being on this ballot EAB will not be able to get anything on the ballot for the next 4 years.

*Leg Council has not voted on this issue yet. Which is why it is needed to know if other groups would be supporting this measure.

*Drawback would be that if many students disagree with this initiative EAB would be putting their name on it (bad publicity?)

*2500 people, if every couple groups get a hundred votes then it could pass

*All AS groups that have lock in fee, MCC, Children Center, CAB, Student Health, all the committees basically.

*The fees haven't been raised in 30 years (flat AS fees)

*Most UC's have already raised fees already and UCSB wants to get on board.

*EAB could campaign on their own which would support a 25 cent raise instead of an 80 dollar

*After this year campus elections probably won't happen after this year, supporting one election

*Since it isn't a campus election there is not a sliding scale

*This will be over in 3 weeks

*How much campaigning would EAB have to do so that AS doesn't look bad

*It is a big deal how other AS groups look at EAB, EAB has proved to be a force on campus
