  - Passing around survey about preference of date/time, style, etc. of meeting
  - EAB will be changing meeting time to Wednesdays at 7:00PM in GSA lounge
- Doreen Farr
  - Was Election Day!!! Vote to make a difference
  - No on 23 is ahead
  - Have internships/partnerships available
    - Contact Ester Agrulera, has been working with UCSB administration
  - At the county level on environmental issues
    - The county is part of a Climate Action Strategy
    - SBCAG: Planning housing where jobs are, focusing on transit, widening Highway 1 (include a HOV lane)
    - Air quality issues—APCD, annually update the clean air plan
    - Reducing energy consumption, water usage
    - Retrofitting buildings
