Description: The 2nd International Women's Encounter, hosted by "Women in Capoeira" from Capoeira Sul da Bahia will be held March 4-7, 2010 at UCSB. The mission is to build community amongst women in Capoeira and providing a safe, encouraging space for women to unite and to learn this martial art from other women as mentors. The event will include 3 ½ days of workshops, lectures and performances as well as team building amongst women on the UCSB campus together with Capoeiristas from all over California, the US, Canada and Brazil. Women instructors from all over California, Canada - and even Brazil, will teach the workshops. There will be free classes on Thursday, followed by a Brazilian Capoeira Cultural Show and Brazilian meal. On Friday, we will host two workshops and an open Roda (where everyone gets a chance to "play" and music is played for the Capoeiristas). There will be workshops all day on Saturday as well as Sunday morning and afternoon. There will be a workshop on Thursday that is open to everyone – males and females - and the Brazilian cultural show is open to everyone. Traditionally, like most martial arts, Capoeira has been dominated by men, but recently many women have entered the sport. In fact, just 15 years ago, women were not allowed to play.

Participating in Capoeira events can be intimidating to women and women often cannot fully participate due to the domination of the men in the activities. Capoeira Sul da Bahia is unique in that 80% of our students are women and it is an ideal place for women to practice. We felt compelled to create an opportunity for women to gather and to bring women capoeiristas together from all over California to practice and inspire each other. We hope that through the free classes available to UCSB students that we can share this unique martial art and culture and encourage self-empowerment, strength, confidence and team building. We chose the first weekend in March as it was the closest to International Women's Day – March 8th – to celebrate as well as to honor the women that have come before us, united together and helped to break barriers so that we would have more opportunity and role models for organizing \*

Capoeira (kah-poo-e-da) is a blend of martial art and dance set to the rhythmic music of Brazilian instruments. Developed by African slaves in colonial Brazil it combines a variety of strikes, acrobatics, and fluid articulation in movement. Practitioners develop a distinct perspective of union, community, and respect inherent in the Capoeira culture. Capoeira was instrumental in beginning to break down racial barriers and in securing freedom for slaves in Brazil. Now people of all races, nationalities, gender, and economic backgrounds practice Capoeira all over the world.
