B. Public Forum

2. Actuarial Association at UCSB

Actuarial Association: We were tabled last week for our request. There will be a half day event hosted by the Actuarial Science program. This is open to all students. We are requesting money for guest speakers, housing for non-UCSB students. We are requesting \$3500 to reimburse for all registration fees, 150 people- 25 per student, and this will be on a first-come first-serve basis.

I. Liu: We needed clarification. Our board had concerns that it costs money to be in your club and this opportunity is only open for them.

Actuarial Association: We reimbursed only members in the past but we will also open up this opportunity to other students outside our organization. So we will reimburse everyone.

Cook: How are you advertising this event?

Actuarial Association: We will send out emails to departments and we have advertised to students outside UCSB and UCSB. There has been some social media advertisement.

3. Community Financial Fund (CFF)

CFF: We are requesting to travel to the Louisiana Financial Literacy Conference. We will be taking notes and recording throughout the conference. We will use things we learned here to implement in the upcoming quarters workshops.

4. La Comunidad Latinx Graduación (CLG)

CLG: We recently went under a new name. We are requesting funding for Graduation for Latinx students but it is open to other students too. We are actually requesting \$17,000 for a stage and a sound system. There was also an increase of about 100 students this year. It will be taking place in a harder stadium.

I. Liu: Increase is for staging and sound system?

CLG: Yes

Cook: What would you prioritize for funding?

CLG: Harder stadium and the sound system, 10,000 for the 100 participant increase is important.

5. Legal Education Association for Diversity (LEAD)

LEAD: We are requesting \$3082 for our Spring SoCal trip. We will be taking 30 UCSB students to law schools and provide housing for one night at a hotel, rental cars, and parking fees.

I. Liu: Are you willing to use your one time exception for travel?

6. East African Student Association

East African Student Association: We are the only african serving organization on campus. We are hosting an African Cultural show. It will take place in Corwin Pavilion. We are asking for \$838.97 for the rental of Corwin and we are also having the Ambassador of Ghana to come talk and the venue for an open market space.

I. Liu: When is this?

East African Student Association: May 7th

Cook: On the request it says 869.

East African Student Association: Yea it is probably that amount.
