Discussion about GSO and GO

Ivan- wants gso to happen because we need to make a blueprint for future sirrc chairs to know how to put on GSO so it doesn't fall apart and not happen anymore, less about what guides and sirrc is and resources and now GO is more about being leaders. We don't have to extremely change GSO, just little by little to at least get progress in the program, it doesn't have to be perfect yet. Mahader said GSO will be possible if Ivan has a couple other people.

Roxana-wants just GO because there needs to be quality and its basically the same as gso except the contracts and ra's and things

Reyna- if we have both, then who is going to work on which project, our people power may split up

Wendy- if we work hard, people can help with both

Mark- doesn't know if we can do quality work and having contracts ready in time,

Lomeli- doesn't think GSO is the best idea just because our hearts are in it, it's not necessarily practical to do it and that we just keep going in circles

Marilyne- if we have gso we need to set aside time and people to be committed to gso, but need to make sure that there is quality and make sure to help gso and go. Make time for BOTH programs.

Iris- Doesn't know difference between GSO and GO, Ivan explained that GSO will be more about resources and learning what SIRRC is

Kelly- GSO can happen, put in time to help with GSO?

Jorge- need to have a vote on whether both programs should take place. For GSO we need to start the program as soon as possible, if decided to take place.

--Ivan says he will present it in a different way and then a vote can happen after that presentation and the people that will vote on Monday will be the people that are going to work on the project such as chairs here and kelly, iris, ivan and wendy will vote too

Ivan-Working on dietary needs paperwork, program is more of a walking tour mcc, dlg, ucn, stork tower, career and counselor services, srb, created a contact list for the workshops, two lectures, ra stuff, \$5,700 budget, checklist for students, required documents for students whether they are minors, agendas and applications finalized and completed, want to send out emails to students tomorrow, deadlines
-the mentors? who is going to get the mentors GSO? or GO?

Difference between GO and GSO?

- GO is more about leadership and GSO is more about getting to know resources
- incorporate GO and GSO
- same 30 students for both
- can it actually be done? enough people power?
- we already have modified agendas and workshops from last year that can be edited
- wanted to do gso, but retention chairs are not here to spearhead the project and there were only about four people here, roxy suggested to do it in the fall, and we could put more effort into the GO program, since students would have already been here, we wanted it to be more leadership based, and now gso is back on discussion

Problems

- not a lot of people could make the 2 o'clock meetings to vote on gso or go
- is it on legal code that retention chairs must be here during summer? should put on legal code that they can't just have to take care of gso, but they actually have to be here

Mahader

- limited resources in summer, make it more conceivable program in fall, one way we can continue gso easier is to make it to fall so contracts and other factors aren't as daunting, 3 weeks is not enough time to put on gso, and it would be more effective to put efforts towards GO and book bank and events happening in the fall, sense disenfranchisement from voting for gso
- make sure we are being democratic, anybody who is a voting member of sirrc even ones that aren't here
- getting 30 students to come in three weeks to gso would be a feat

ivan-we have the numbers because we have 72 students available this year versus 40 last year and three weeks instead of two

- need to vote asap

julian-working on both gso and go at the same time cuts down effectiveness for each

mahader-not only contacting, but transportation for all the students to get here, basic aspects such as ra's on staff, hired and ready, sirrc members are trained for youth and first aid which is all happening in context of summer

-one vote about go and gso and then under that see who will be committed to helping and who is here for the summer, the vote requires multiple levels and its not just black and white

- this survey will take time away if gso does happen

- vote needs to be made by wednesday

Structure of Vote

-email your vote, include disclaimer about who is going to be working the most, don't be an advocate for something you can't work for because individual and sirrc reputation is on the line

-Need better communication and organization

-GO is supposed to be GSO minus the summer aspect, GO is based off GSO,

-there is not enough time to put on an amazing GSO
