PUBLIC FORUM

1. I.V. Youth Projects – LuAnn Miller, executive director, requested \$29,800 to fund 22 UCSB work study students for the children's center and after school program. These students would work all year for a program used mainly by Isla Vista and other local working families.

2. Improvability – Kolby Knickerbocker requested \$1,200 to help fund Improvability's shows with the hope to expand the shows into a major Friday night event in Isla Vista. The money would go toward more advertising in the newspaper and other permanent advertising such as keychains, stickers, etc.

3. I.V. Teen Center – Leonor Reyes, program director, requested \$10,098 to support year-long UCSB employees at the teen center. The teens benefit from long-term employees because the employees can become mentors and have time to establish a meaningful relationship with members of the teen center.

ACTION ITEMS, VOTING ON REQUESTS

1. Funds for Improvability
