• LuAnn Miller- IV Youth Projects:

Isla Vista Youth Projects has been around since 1971, and offers after school activities for young children, as well as infant/toddler/preschool care program for younger children. The Youth Project seeks to offer children a positive alternative to the problems that come from growing up in a crowded, low-income urban community. IVCRC has funded IV Youth Projects since 1998, and has been a key support for the program. The money requested is to provide IV Youth Projects with money to pay the UCSB students whom work at the school year round.

Request: \$30,320

• Leonor Reyes- IV Teen Center YMCA:

Teen center serves 6th-12th graders, seeks to provide a safe space for students and children. The teen center provides a variety of programs including: Tutoring and homework assistance, computer access, alcohol and other drug education, health education groups, youth and family counseling, college workshops, job readiness workshops, leadership groups, and more. All services are completely free. Many students and Grads from UCSB help support the Teen Center, working to help the students. The money they are requesting is to fund 3 part time staff (ucsb students) and program supplies.

Request: \$10,942

• Christy Escobar- Non-Partisan Vote Concert:

The Non partisan Voter Registration Drive is looking hold a fun, informative event highlighting the importance of voting local and state wide. They are planning to put on a Voting Rocks! Concert in Anisqoyo Park on 10/14/06, for five hours during the day. Activities will include live music, speech by local politicians, non-partisan issues. Money is requested is to fund sound and event costs.

Request: \$2,325.

• Nancy Davis- City @ Peace

A youth development program that uses the performing arts to teach and promote cross-cultural understanding, leadership skills, and non-violent conflict resolution. The group targets teens 13-19, and meets for 4 hours every week to create a play based on their lives, with help from students from UCSB, SBCC, and other places. The students than put on they play themselves. The students also adopt a community change project, where the students pick a project (such as voter registration), and pursue it for the year. The money they request would be to fund a portion of the costs of the production of the program.

Request: \$7,000
