ChillaVista:

The community group ChillaVista is putting on their 2nd annual ChillaVista festival, "an interactive celebration of community". This follows the enormous success of last years festival. The spring festival will encourage community interaction and empowerment through the exploration of art, music, media, and food. The goal is to bind the residents of Isla Vista into a cohesive, unified group working toward an improved public image, while also celebrating diversity in the Isla Vista community. They are requesting money to help fund the essentials, such as park permits, insurance, tent and stage rentals, and a few other things such as t-shirts, promotions, ect.

Request: \$8,006

Derpa-sherpa-palooza:

Two students are organizing a festival, Derpa-Sherpa-Palooza, to help and promote a new documentary called "Isla Vista in Movement", about the many social organizations in Isla Vista. The purpose is to expose these organizations, and the purpose of the festival is a large promotion of the festival, and a chance to bring the organizations together. The money they are requesting is to fund the park deposits, promotion, sound, tables, garbage cans, and general supplies, and bands.

Request: 3,760

I.V. Community Bag Project:

Melissa from the IV food Co-op is starting a project to create an IV bag, to replace the numerous plastic and paper bags used at various stores in Isla Vista. The idea is an organic cotton tote bag, with the logos of all the businesses involved, including the newly formed "Blue IV" recycling project. It is a way to reduce waste (by implementing re-usable bags), and create a way to connect the businesses and make a cohesive community. Melissa's goal is to have the initial purchase of 5,000 bags funded by IVCRC (and have us be the main sponsor of the project), and have the bags distributed to all the businesses signed up in Isla Vista. The businesses would than sell the bags for only a dollar, with a signed contract that the profit from the bags will go towards purchasing more bags, therefore it is a self-generating project after the initial funding. Sponsors already include Keg n bottle, IV Market, the Co-Op, IV Surf Company. It is a way to bond the community and create a positive, long lasting change. If ordered in time, the bags could be unveiled at ChillaVista.
