II. Funding Requests

a. IVYP

- i. The Youth Projects provide childcare for 150 children. They help children get to the dentist and provide various resources for families. They serve 250-300 children each day. This is a really good service for families. The money goes to hire work-study students. The funding helps keep the program affordable. IV Youth Projects has been trying to raise funds and keep their door opens. They have been fund-raising on their own. They started a training program this quarter. The students go to a webinar and then bring back ideas to the group.

There's serious danger concerning ppl's lives. Maybe IVCRC and EAB have more stand to be against. People get aggressive when others talk about the environmental impact. But when educated, they would understand and take a more responsible stand. If aaron can turn it into a positive event, the IVCRC is 100% for it. We would like to see a deliberate preparation. Alternative event? Not many ppl go. One, expand Barbaras campaign: can be separate from AS; through IVCRC and EAB – no on floatopia. A separate committee for the campaign. An event with the elders or small children, so that people would want to go to the beach on that day to party? Kellie would like to set up the meetin with EAB about the campaign. People might still go to the event, even though there is no formal planning. Our focus is the people who might go to the event. Don't want to be affiliated with the IVFP.
