RHA:

This quarter, RHA was able to expand the Period Pantry and provide menstrual products in the female-identifying and gender-neutral restrooms of ALL nine residence halls. RHA also provided free testing materials in each of our offices, reaching approximately 500 students. We also hosted a variety of successful All Hall events as an organization; All Hall Ball and All Hall Brawl both had record turn-out and are a fun part of the residential living experience as well as an alternative to IV on a weekend night. Our chair coordinators and representatives worked with the Hall Councils and provided a number of educational and social events in the halls. Finally, the housing rate increases will be marginal for the 2019-2020 school year and are only increasing in accordance with CPI, marking one of the lowest housing rate changes in years. Next quarter, we'll be continuing to expand the Period Pantry and condom distribution programs and to put on events in the residence halls. We'll also be working on making testing and school supplies more accessible to residents and on collaborating with ResNet to improve internet connectivity.
