Statement of Purpose:

IDEAS (Improving Dreams Equality Access and Success) was established in 2006 by undocumented students that felt an absence in representation on the UCSB campus and longed for a support group.

Our mission is to provide support and advocate for undocumented students at UCSB and in the community. Through this mission, IDEAS provides financial, academic, and emotional support to all of our students through scholarships, workshops, and by simply having a safe place for undocumented students, allies, and students that come from mixed status immigrant families to share their experiences.

This retreat is greatly valuable for IDEAS as it aligns with our mission to provide a safe space for all students that can relate to the hardships and struggles of being undocumented, to share their voices with one another, and create greater connections. In the midst of today's anti-immigrant political atmosphere and the fear that is has put upon immigrants in this country, it is very important that members of our organization and other students affected are given this opportunity to create a stronger organization that puts the efforts to advocate for the needs of the undocumented community.

This retreat aims to:

- 1. Provide unity within the UCSB undocumented community, students from mixed-status families, and allies amidst a national anti-immigrant sentiment.
- 2. Empower a new generation of undocumented students, students from mixed-status families, and allies to carry on the efforts of advocating for the undocumented community.
- 3. Provide Community building and leadership growth.
- 4. Provide students with the opportunity for self-care and healing.
- 5. Create a stronger Community and network within the IDEAS Organization and the Undocumented community at UCSB.
