OUTLINE OF AS FOOD BANK EXPANSION PROJECT

EARLY STAGES OF PROJECT (FALL QUARTER):

- Growing number of students now utilizing AS Food Bank pantry:
 - Lobby too small to accommodate large crowds of waiting clients.
 - Staff unable to operate in cramped, crowded space.
- Submitted proposal for additional space to the UCEN Governance Board:
 - Proposal first approved by the AS Food Bank committee (10/28/16).
 - Proposal accepted by the UCEN Governance Board (11/14/16):
 - o Re-allocated half of the adjacent study room to the AS Food Bank.

RENOVATION OF NEW AND OLD SPACE:

- The additional space will be utilized as the new AS Food Bank lobby:
 - o The study room will be divided by a wall.
 - The AS Food Bank's portion will be newly furnished with more seating.
 - A door (currently not in use) already connects the new space with the pantry:
 - This will be utilized as the new pantry entrance.
 - After the pantry's operational hours, the new lobby can potentially be used as a study lounge or meeting room for other AS organizations.
- The pantry and old lobby area will also be renovated, which will include:
 - o Removal of the current carpeting and abatement for potential asbestos.
 - This will bring the AS Food Bank up to Environmental Health & Safety codes.
 - New paint job for the rooms, including those in the EAB lounge and office.
 - New furniture for the Food Bank office and pantry.
- The old lobby area will be utilized for shelves for fresh produce items:
 - o In the future, the area can house refrigeration.
 - With refrigeration, more varieties of produce can be purchased and safely offered to students using our service:
 - Edible Campus will also donate produce from the student farm to the pantry; this gives them to more options to grow, harvest, and donate.
 - Submitted a TGIF grant proposal for potential refrigeration next year.
- Project will take 4 to 5 weeks to complete:
 - o Will need a temporary location to service students during renovation.
 - The old faculty club is a potential space:
 - Located 2nd floor of the UCEN, near Subway.
 - Walls need to come down soon; deconstruction will happen if the expansion project does not begin by spring break at the latest.
 - If there are any other possible locations, **please let us know**.

COST OF RENOVATION:

- Flooring / Pulling Carpet in 4 Rooms + Space for Wall: \$14,083.42
- Couches: \$5,176.56
- Installing Wall & Painting 5 Rooms, Doors, Ceilings: \$26,875.00
- Total: \$46,134.98

FUNDING:

- The Food Security Taskforce has allocated \$20,875 in funding to be used by end of year.
 - o If not used by June, the funding will no longer be available.
- Additional funding will come from the AS Food Bank's "special projects" budget:
 - Funding from the "refrigeration" and "furniture & supplies" budgets will be re-allocated into "special projects"; this will provide an additional \$10,000.
- Funding for furniture will come from Capital Reserves.
- EAB will provide funding for their portion of the paint job.
- Additional funding will be requested from outside sources, such as senate.
- Remaining Funding Needed: \$11,259.98
