**What**: Associated Students wants to acknowledge the current stress levels and well being of students in the aftermath of the Thomas fire and recent events in the Isla Vista community. We want to respond to these issues by bringing the community together in a Town Hall to discuss these issues, ask questions and find solutions. This event will be held on April 3<sup>rd</sup> at 6:00pm next quarter by the EVPLA office.

Why: This event will be held out of necessity to address the overall mental health, drug abuse, and stress of students. This is directed to the campus officials, leadership, faculty, staff, and our fellow students. At a meeting held on March 7<sup>th</sup> with UCSB and Isla Vista officials and experts it became clear very quickly that we are experiencing an unprecedented level of mental health effects due to stress and dire circumstances. Some of these circumstances are outside of our control, some of them within our control. We need to talk about these differences and we need to take action. We are calling this event "Pause." because need to take a moment to evaluate our current situation. And we invite you to Pause. from self medication, from self harm, and from other destructive actions towards yourself and others and come together and talk about it.
