- II. Guerrilla Girls w/ ASPB

 - a. Allocations
 - We need to set the amount of money we will allocate to outside organizations and how to cap outside allocations.
 - A motion to set \$4,000 of our budget for outside group allocations passed 7/7
 - A motion to set \$1500 of our allocation budget for Fall and Spring, \$1,000 for Winter quarter passed 5/7. Any amount left over at the end of the quarter would rollover
 - We started the discussion on individual allocation caps/regulations. We created a hierarchy for funding outside groups. We will be funding groups/events that (1) deal with a direct sexual violence issue; (2) groups/events that deal with sexual violence issues in the periphery; and (3) non sexual violence related events, but proceeds will be donated to a sexual violence charity. Allocation caps will be set for these categories.
