II. Funding Request

- a. Desiree is requesting \$250 for the Students of Color Conference (SOCC) through AS SCORE. Every non-UCSB student will be charged \$25 at the Conference. Their budget is \$55,000 and have/plan to request money from Finance Board, RHA, Coord Board, and other BCCS

III. Budget

- a. External Allocation cap discussion
 - For Fall and Spring, we decided at last meeting to set aside \$1,500 for external allocations. For winter, we set aside 1,000 (all extra \$ will rollover)
 - We discussed how much we want to set aside for each of our 3 tiers
 - o Motion: for fall and spring quarters, we will set aside \$800 for tier 1 (group or event dealing directly with sexual violence), \$500 for tier 2 (groups or events that deal with sexual violence issues in the periphery), and \$200 for tier 3 (non sexual violence related but dealing with empowerment through knowledge)

- Motion: For winter quarter, we will set aside \$500 for tier 1, \$300 for tier 2, and \$200 for tier 3
