For the past eight years, Invisible Children has worked to end civil war in Northern Uganda and specifically the use of children as soldiers in conflict. While the LRA rebels do not discriminate on the children they kidnap, young girls are the ones most disadvantaged. As with other any other war or military conflict, women are disproportionately affected. Young girls from 7-14 are kidnapped and kept as sex slaves. Because of their relation to LRA generals they are kept close at hand and in the worst position to escape. Jolly Okot, Uganda director of Invisible Children, was a former child soldier herself and knows personally the plight of these girls. Our schools in Northern Uganda house girls who carry the children of their former perpetrators. This November, at our fall screening, we have the great honor of bringing two female students to our campus.
